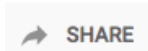


A change in the YouTube API is limiting the number of calls Blackboard can make against it each day, which resulted in errors when using the YouTube mashup tool in Blackboard. For this reason, we have removed the YouTube mashup option from Blackboard at this time. You can still embed a YouTube video into Blackboard by following the directions below.

Embedding a YouTube Video

To Embed a YouTube video in Blackboard:

1. Go to YouTube and find the video.
2. Click on the **Share** button under the video.

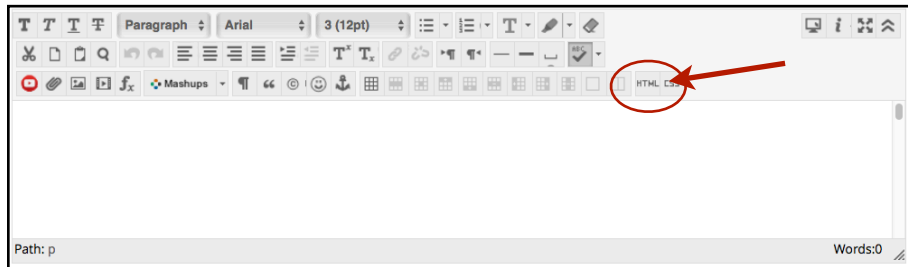
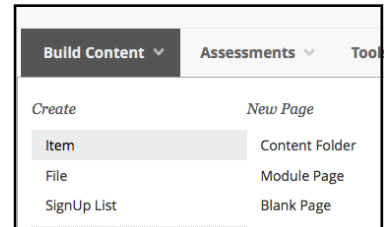


3. Click on the **Embed** tab.

4. Highlight and copy the iframe code. Cntl+C (windows) or Command+C (mac) to copy.
5. Go to your Blackboard course content area in which you want to embed the video and choose **Build Content – Item**.
6. Click on the HTML button in the right of the Content Editor.



7. Paste the video into the HTML code view window using Cntl+V (windows) or Command+V (mac)
8. Click the **Update** button. You should see a yellow box in the the Content Editor where the video should be.
9. Click the **Submit** button to save your item
