WHY RECYCLE PRINTER INK CARTRIDGES?

Environmental Benefits:

HP Planet Partners

- HP accepts only HP ink and toner cartridges for recycling.
- The program offers free recycling via prepaid shipping labels or drop-off locations (Walmart Oxford).

Canon Cartridge Recycling Program

- Canon accepts Canon ink and toner cartridges only.
- Free shipping labels and drop-off options are provided for recycling.

Epson Recycling Program

- Epson accepts Epson ink cartridges and toner cartridges.
- Provides free prepaid shipping labels for returns.

Xerox Green World Alliance

- Accepts Xerox cartridges and toner.
- Provides free return shipping and Eco Box kits for multiple cartridges.
- Supports large volume returns with pallet pickup.

Brother

- Brother accepts only Brother Genuine ink cartridges, toner cartridges, and drum units for recycling.
- Supports large volume returns with pallet pickup.
- Offers free recycling through prepaid shipping labels or recycling kits mailed directly to participants.

Konica Minolta Clean Planet Program

- Accepts genuine OEM toner cartridges from Konica Minolta and HP brands (empty or unused).
- Provides free prepaid shipping boxes and UPS labels for recycling (minimum 10 cartridges per box).
- Supports pallet pickups for large volumes (minimum 100 cartridges).

Inkrecycling.org

- This national initiative accepts all used HP and Canon brands, offering up to **\$3 for every** empty ink cartridge you send in.
- The payment varies based on the type and condition of the cartridges.
- Free shipping kits are available for those returning in bulk. <https://www.inkrecycling.org/?mystep=2&brand=hp>

TonerBuyer

- This program accepts **original equipment** manufacturer (OEM) ink and toner cartridges from any brand (no remanufactured or refilled cartridges).
- **\$6 to \$0.25** for every empty ink cartridge you send in depending on brand.

- They supply prepaid UPS shipping labels for mail-in recycling and resale.
- A minimum quantity is required for free shipping (8 laser or 25 ink jet cartridges per box).
- If original boxes are not available, cartridges should be individually wrapped to avoid damage.
- Payments are processed within 5 business days after inspection. <https://tonerbuyer.com/packing-and-shipping-instructions/>

Why recycle your toner?

- Generate money from your building's waste.
- Conserves natural resources such as oil, timber, water, and metals used in cartridge production.
- Reduces waste, emissions, and energy consumption associated with manufacturing new cartridges.
- Helps prevent toxic chemicals and heavy metals from contaminating soil and water.
