INFORMATION CONCERNING GENERAL RULES, REGULATIONS AND MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

DEGREE REQUIREMENTS:

- 1. At least **124** semester hours
- 2. At least 30 semester hours or residence credit in the school
- 3. Not more than 33 semester hours of correspondence and extension credit
- 4. Not more than **61** semester hours of credit from a community transfer college

Teacher Education Program Admission to Phase II:

- 1. Completion of core curriculum and EDCI 352 (minimum grade C)
- 2. Minimum GPA of 2.75 on Core
- 3. Appropriate Praxis Core, SAT, or ACT scores OR overall 3.0 GPA on 60 + hours
- 4. Must complete education courses with a "C" or better.
