**INFORMATION CONCERNING GENERAL RULES, REGULATIONS AND MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS**

**DEGREE REQUIREMENTS:**

1. At least **124** semester hours
2. At least **30** semester hours or residence credit in the school
3. Not more than **62** semester hours of credit from a community transfer college
4. No more than **6** of the last **21** hours may be transfer credit.

**Teacher Education Program Admission to Phase II:**

1. Completion of core curriculum and EDCI 352 (minimum grade C)
2. Minimum GPA of 2.75 on Core
3. Appropriate Praxis Core, SAT, or ACT scores OR overall 3.0 GPA on 60+ hours
4. Must complete education courses with a "C" or better.
