

# TRANSFER TO TEACH

Transfer to Teach aims to encourage top-performing Mississippi community college transfer students to pursue a career in education. Students participating in the program will receive financial support **up to \$5,000 for each of their junior and senior years** at the University of Mississippi, as well as the following incentives:

- Full annual financial support (estimated up to \$5,000 after all other aid is applied)
- Up to \$1,000 technology reimbursement (to be used to purchase a laptop or tablet of their choice)
- \$1,000 allowance for a professional development experience
- \$250 annually for books and other required classroom supplies

In exchange, fellows will agree to serve in Mississippi public schools for at least three years following the graduation. This service requirement may be paused if Fellows pursue a graduate degree. Graduates unable to complete their service commitment will repay a proportional amount of scholarship monies received.

Funding for Transfer to Teach is made possible by the generosity of Gene and Kathy Bishop of Dallas, TX and the Tri State Educational Foundation in Iuka, MS.

## Eligibility

- Transferring to the University of Mississippi from one of Mississippi's community or junior colleges
- Incoming full-time junior majoring in education
- Desire to teach in Mississippi public schools following graduation
- Incoming GPA of 3.0
- Composite ACT of 23
- Additional consideration for students transferring from Northeast Mississippi Community College and Itawamba Community College
