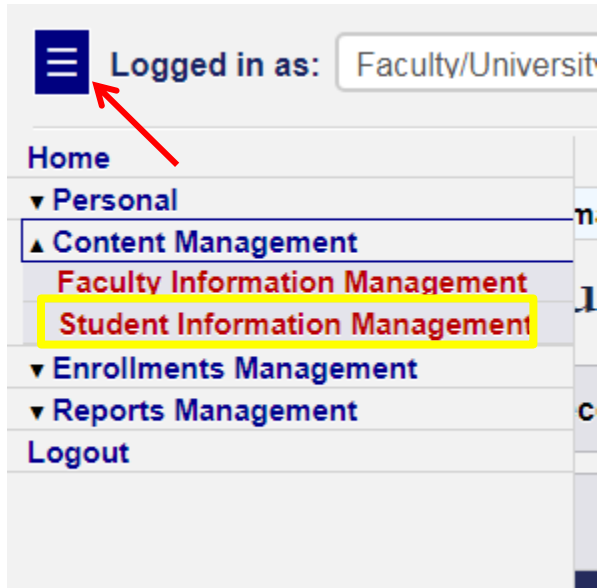


# Counselor Ed: Accessing Individual Instrument Reports

In the School of Education's Assessment System, faculty have access to individual instrument reports on a candidate.

Follow the steps below to successfully access individual instrument reports:

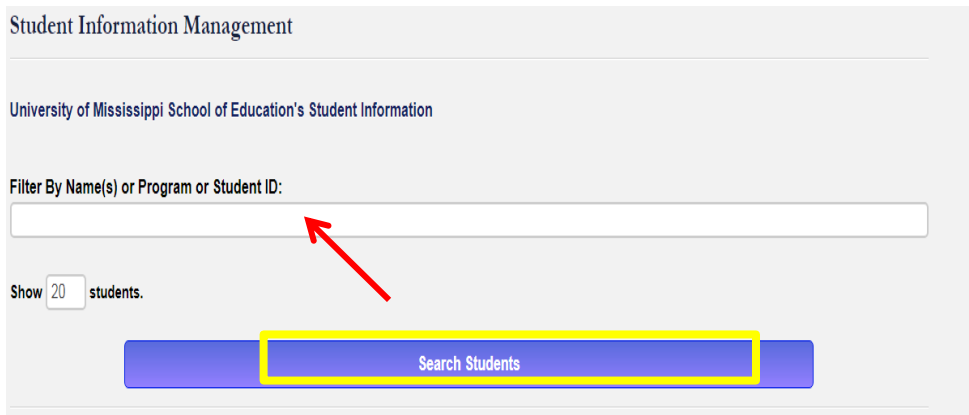


Click the Navigation Menu button (the blue square) after logging in.

Then, click "Content Management."

Next, click "Student Information Management" from the drop down menu.



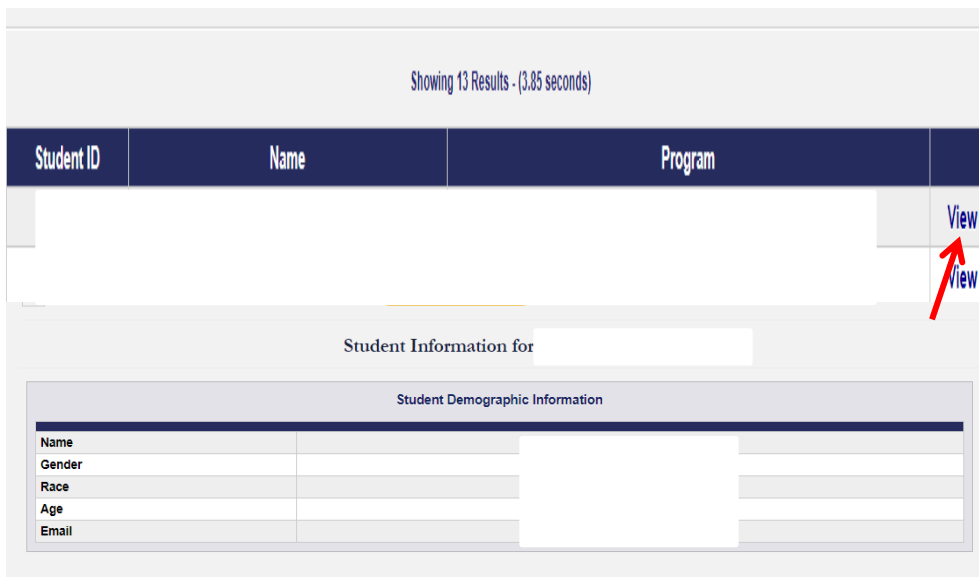
The "Student Information Management" page will open.

To search for a candidate, type their name or student ID number into the white bar.

Next, click the purple "Search Students" button.

Scroll down the page until the heading "Assessment Instrument Reports." Any previously submitted instruments will be listed.

Next, click the blue "View" button to the instrument.

On the next page you may select filters to narrow your choice, but you do not have to.

Click "Generate Report."

The "Submissions" box will appear on the same page after the report generates.

Click "View Report" next to the submission you want.

The report will open on a new page and list the scores for each indicator on the instrument. Any written comments will also be listed.

If you wish to print a copy of the report, you may do so by hitting "Command" and "C" on your keyboard for Mac users. If you are using a PC, you may right click and then, click "Print."
