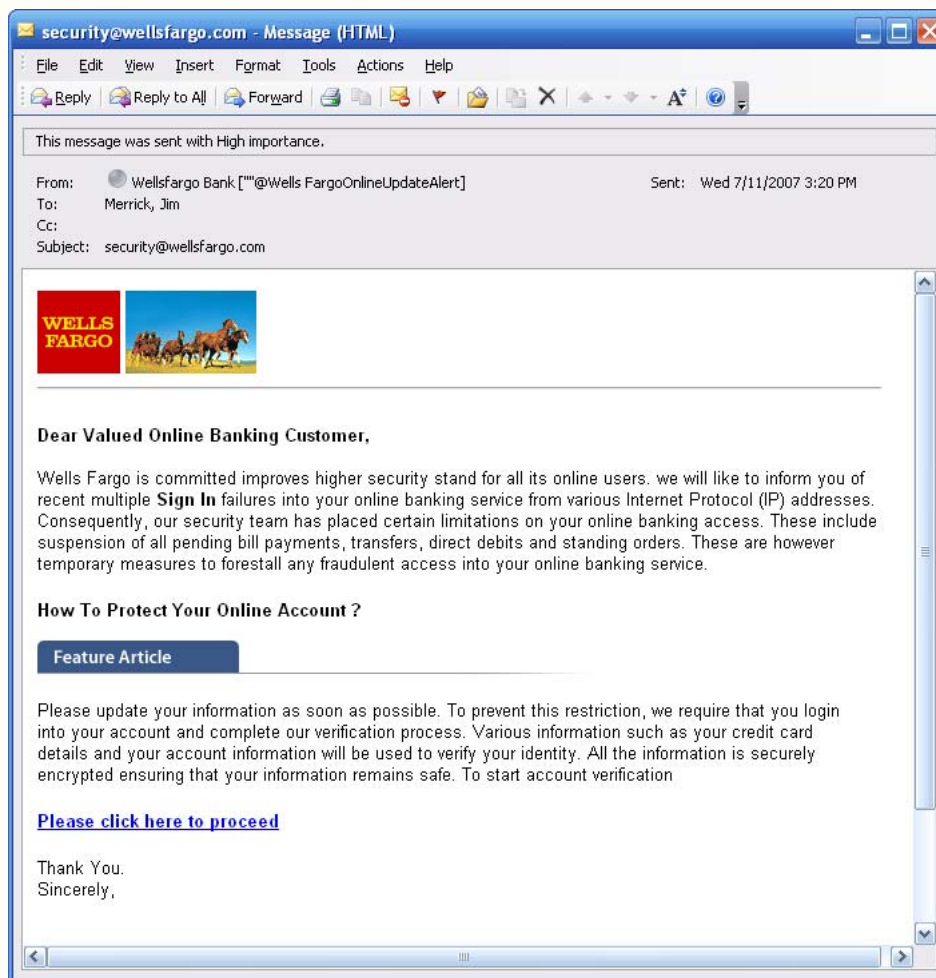
Server Security

■ Phishing

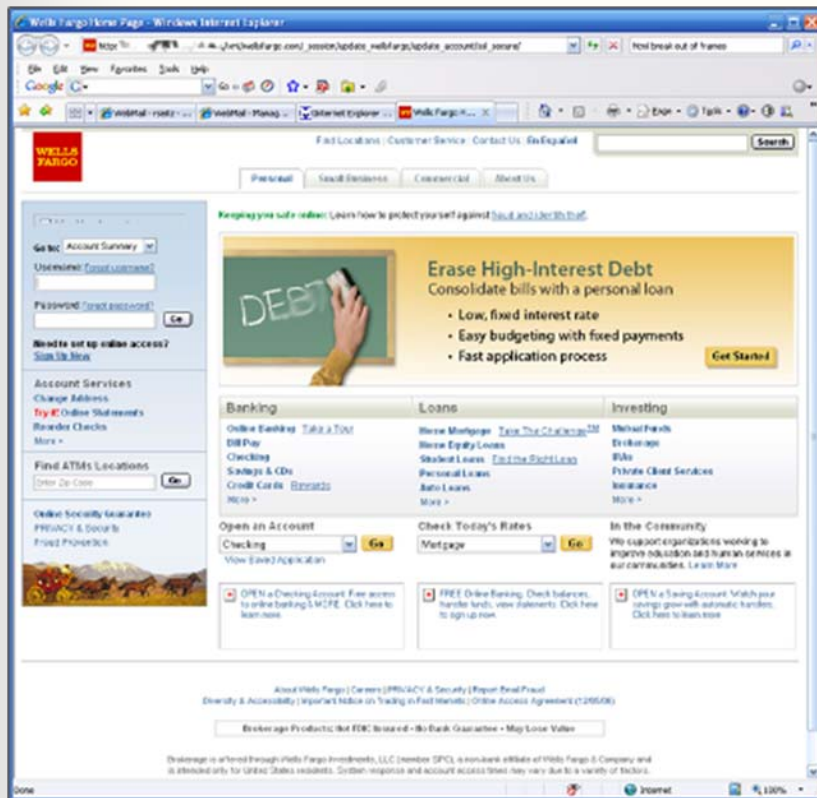
In computing, **phishing** is a criminal activity using social engineering techniques.^[1] Phishers attempt to fraudulently acquire sensitive information, such as usernames, passwords and credit card details, by masquerading as a trustworthy entity in an electronic communication. eBay and PayPal are two of the most targeted companies, and online banks are also common targets. - wikipedia.org (2:00 PM, July 13)

Server Security Tips

- Know your user accounts.
- Set up specific file and folder permissions.
- Retire old accounts.
- Use *strong* passwords and don't share them.
- Ask about using our Secure server if needed
 - it has a valid security certificate!
