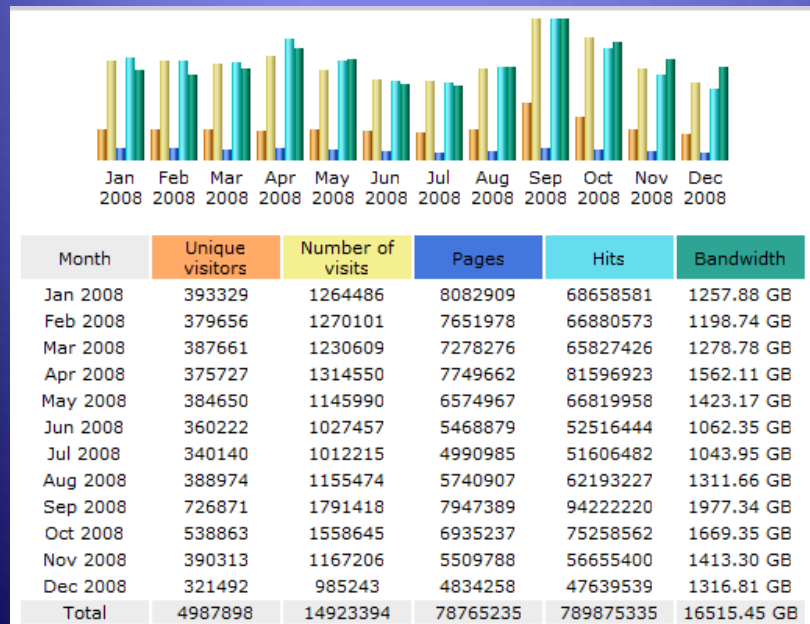

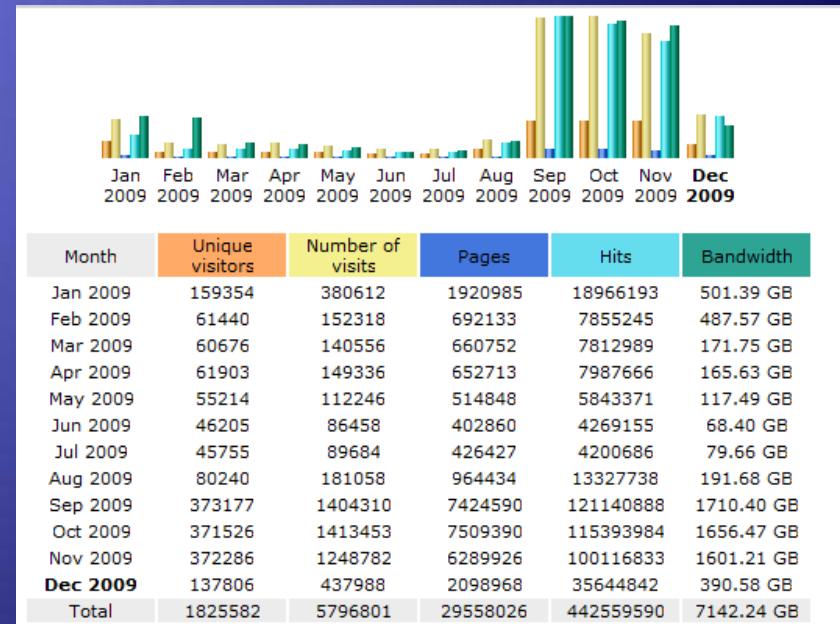
- ◆ New Webmail needed several modifications since it went live before Thanksgiving.

## The Struggle Over Health Care

As the Senate debates a health care bill, [the likelihood is fading](#) that Congress will adopt a "public option", or a government-run insurance program. A [compromise deal](#) appears to be in the works but Senate Majority Leader, Harry Reid of Nevada, has yet to outline it.

In other developments, Senators rejected an [abortion-related amendment](#) offered by Senator Ben Nelson, Democrat of Nebraska, that would have added tougher insurance restrictions. A similar abortion amendment [was adopted by the House](#) and the subject is likely to remain a contentious issue.

The legislation represents a major test for President Obama who has called health care reform his top domestic goal. Mr. Reid [says he hopes](#) to finish work on a health care bill by year's end but that is unlikely.





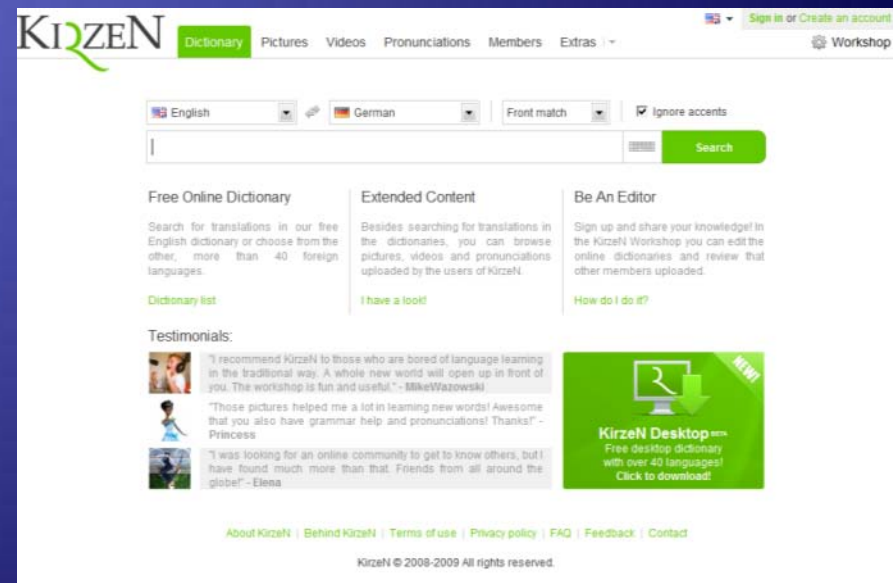

- ◆ MySQL 5.0.67 & 5.1
- ◆ PHP 5.2.9

Tests are currently underway.



# Apache Aliases

- ◆ Note the shorter URL (omitting “/depts/it”)
- ◆ Changes in httpd.conf:

```
RewriteRule ^/depts/it/webmaster/(.+) http://www.olemiss.edu/webmaster/$1  
Alias /webmaster /opt/coolstack/apache2/htdocs/umhome/depts/it/webmaster/
```

- ◆ Allows older links to continue working as before. It simply rewrites the old URL with the new one.
- ◆ Availability offered to schools, departments, and major sub-sites. Just ask...
- ◆ May require changes to HTML correcting relative references to outside the home folder. (eg., <img src=“../images/header.jpg”> had to be changed to <img src=“/depts/it/images/header.jpg”>.) Requires coordination with site webmaster.

# HTML E-mail to Groups

- ◆ Create HTML file as you normally would.
- ◆ Move all graphics on Web server and use absolute references to them in the HTML. (This avoids the need for sending large images via e-mail.)
- ◆ Upload the HTML file to the E2G form.
- ◆ Add file with external e-mail addresses if needed.
- ◆ Click Send.
- ◆ First message to be sent is reminder for Chancellor's Inauguration.
