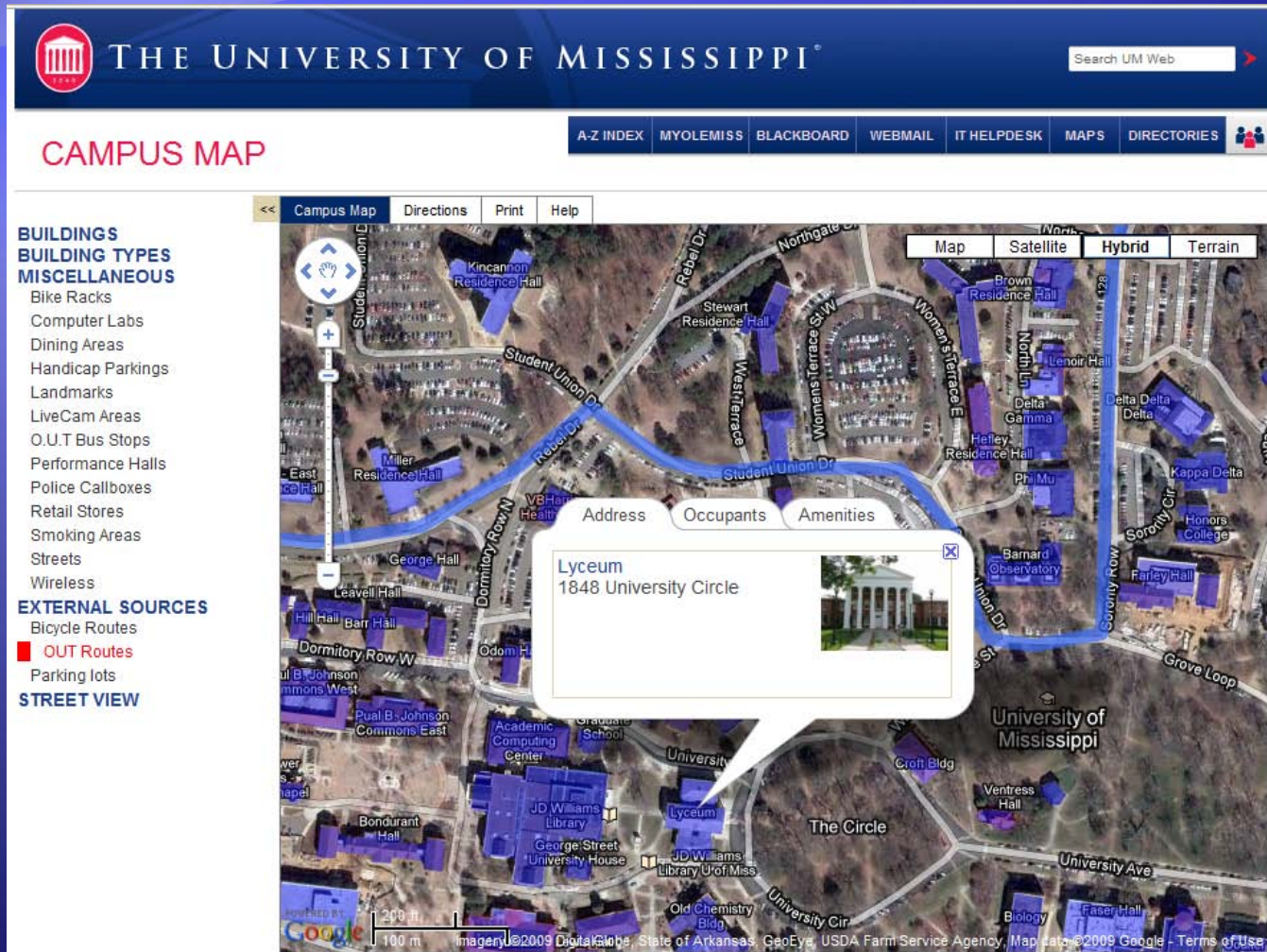

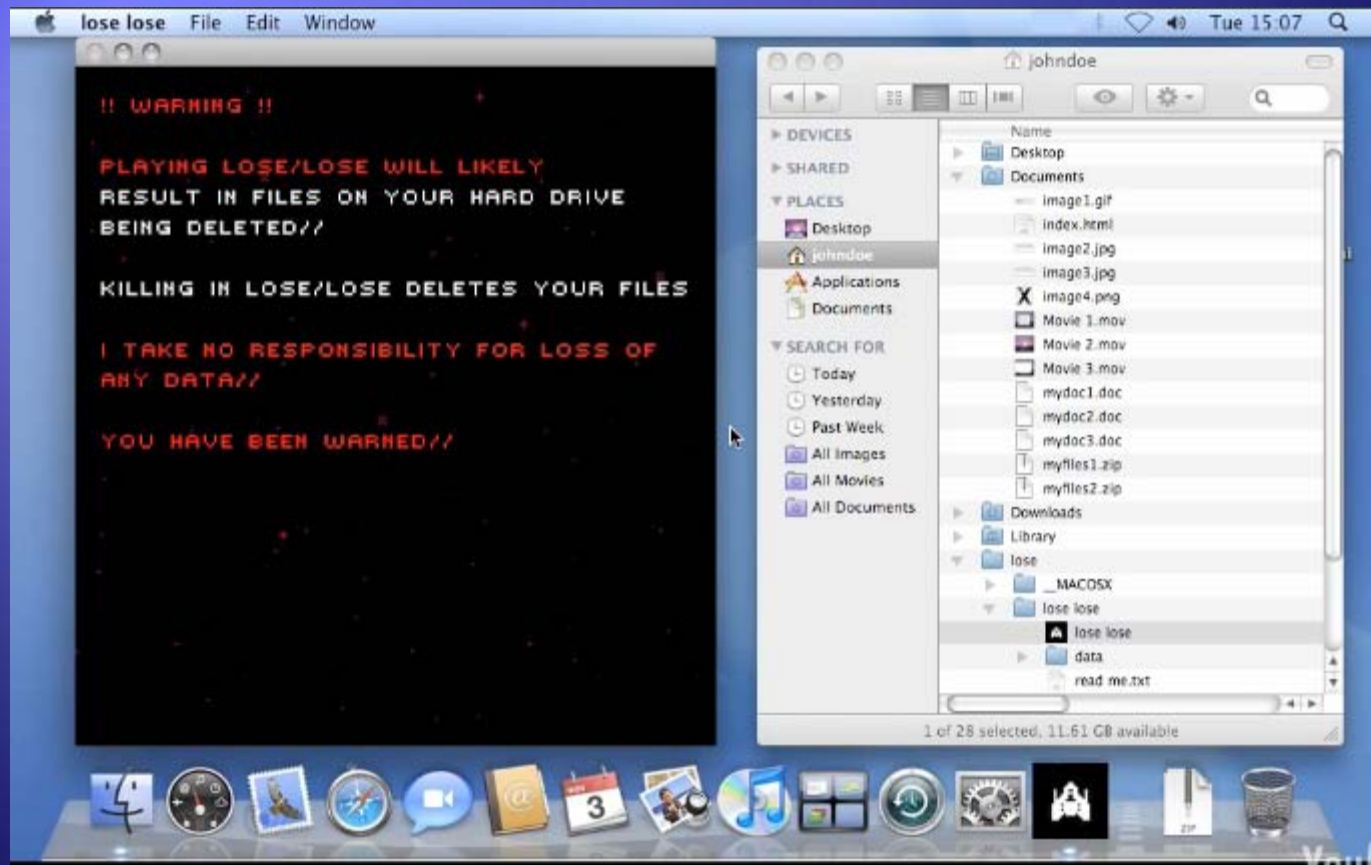

An internet that speaks to you

40th Anniversary of the Internet

The first data was sent over the net just over 40 years ago

Progress towards making the net more multi-lingual is welcome says Bill Thompson.

“It is 40 years to the week since the first data packets were sent over the Arpanet.

That was the research network commissioned by the US Department of Defense Advanced Research Projects Agency (Arpa) to see whether computer-to-computer communications could be made faster, more reliable and more robust by using the novel technique of packet switching instead of the more conventional circuit switched networks of the day.

Instead of connecting computers rather as telephone exchanges work, using switches to set up an electric circuit over which data could be sent, packet switching breaks a message into chunks and sends each chunk - or packet - separately, reassembling them at the receiving end.

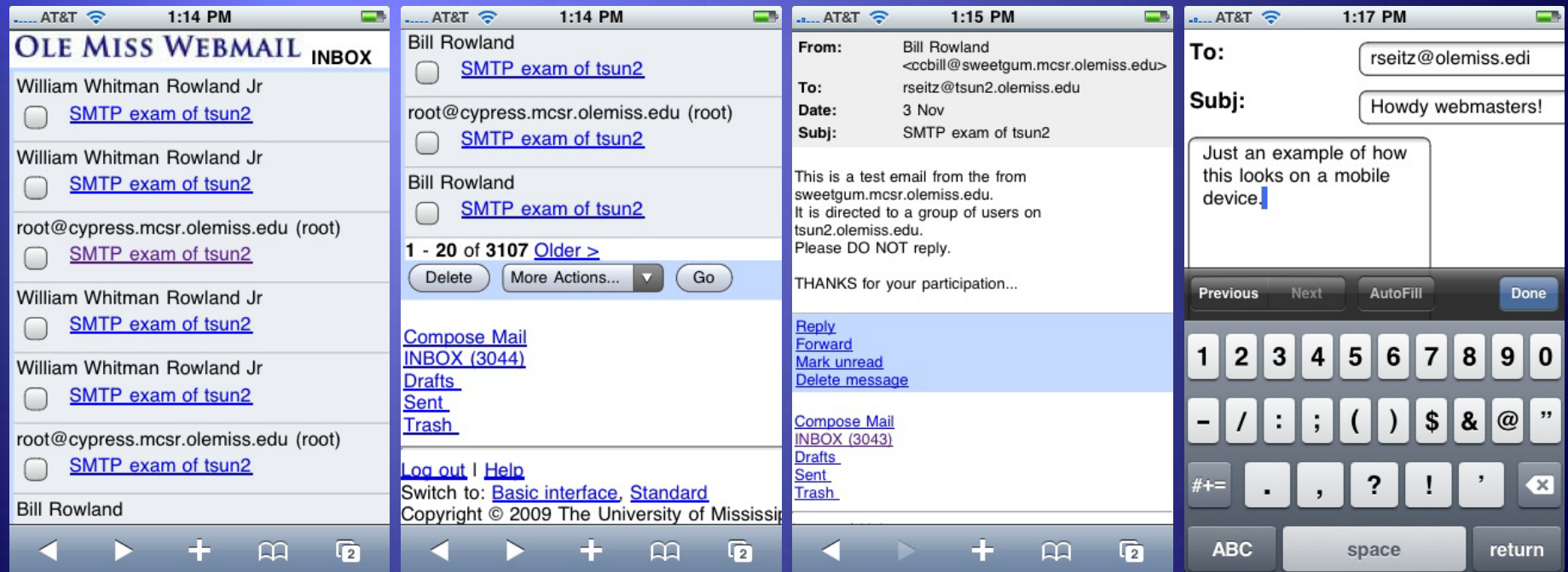
Happy Birthday, Firefox!

- ◆ Open source browser released 11/09/2004.
- ◆ Logged one billionth download on July 31.
- ◆ "We've managed to keep Microsoft honest and forced them to release newer versions of their browsers," [Christopher Blizzard] wrote. "Firefox's presence was a large factor in Apple being able to ship a browser to its user base as the Mac came back to the market. We've made it possible for third party browser vendors like Google to enter the market."
- ◆ Blizzard predicted that, in the next five years, issues around data, privacy, and identity will feature prominently. Users should also look for changes in video "as web developers make individual choices to support a standards-based, royalty-free approach."
- ◆ In the mobile space, meanwhile, "the decisions of users, carriers, governments and the people who build phones will have far-reaching effects on this new extension to the Internet and how people will access information for decades to come," Blizzard said.

- ◆ “... like pulling permanent teeth...”
- ◆ Learning to code pages for Handheld CSS media type.
- ◆ Need to learn to test for and redirect mobile users.

iPhone gets Hacked!

- ◆ First known iPhone worm
- ◆ Can infect any jailbroken iPhone with SSH installed and an unchanged default password.
- ◆ “Jailbreaking” allows iPhone users to run unofficial code bypassing Apple’s official App Store.

Worm is first known iPhone worm, originated in Australia, may be spreading overseas

Rick Astley, an English singer-songwriter and musician, first became famous for his 1987 hit "Never Gonna Give You Up". The [music](#) industry in the 1990s gave up on Astley, but Astley didn't give up on it. He managed to recapture attention in 2007 thanks to one of the most infamous viral [video](#) crazes. Links popped up all around the internet to Astley's hit and the term "[rickrolling](#)", originally referring to tricking people into watching the video, became a common colloquialism.

Now an [internet](#) worm is achieving what Apple has been [unable to do](#) -- punish those with jailbroken iPhones ([phones](#) freed of Apple's app restrictions). Sophos, a leading security firm, appears to be the first to [have investigated](#) the amusing virus. The virus, which "rickrolls" users, changing their wallpaper to an image of Rick Astley. It appears to do little else other than spreading to other jailbroken iPhones in the user's contact list.

The worm can infect any jailbroken iPhone with SSH installed and an unchanged default password. The password on jailbroken iPhones defaults to "alpine". Users can change this by installing the [MobileTerminal](#) app, available from the Cydia
