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The IJP international editorial board members and invited reviewers are respected pavement experts from 16 countries worldwide. They perform the blind-review of submitted papers in the most diligent and constructive way. In the blind review process, the reviewers do not know each other and the names of the author(s). Overall, about 50 percent of the submitted paper manuscripts have been rejected in past years, based on the criteria of originality and contribution to the state of knowledge. Authors are required to provide adequate references including related IJP papers. To ensure originality and quality of submitted papers, each author is required to submit the IJP paper manuscript offer form.

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
