YES	Author's name	Do not use * in bold in primary author's name and address lines, and provide complete mailing address of the primary corresponding author. Do not use titles (Dr., Mr.) with names.
YES	Abstract	Abstract heading must be left justified with no line space. All abstract text should be in one paragraph. Abstract needs improvement. (Show some key results of pavement analysis).
YES	Keywords	Six keywords. Start with first letter of first word in capital, separated by commas, and no period at the end. No abbreviations; spell out acronyms.
YES	Anywhere	Do not use proprietary names of any commercial product in your paper due to IJP strict policy against commercial statements. Simply provide a reference (web page, etc) to benefit readers.
YES	Footer	Use footer margin to 1 cm. Provide use the following correct footer including page number in Time New Roman font size 10. © Copyright IJP 2008 Volume 7 Number 1-2-3 January-May-September 2008 Page 1
YES	Objective	Include clear objectives and scope of the paper in or after Introduction/Background section.
YES	Headings	Use correct section heading formats. Check thoroughly.
YES	Anywhere	Leave only one space after period and before starting a new sentence in all text pages.
YES	Acronyms	Acronyms should be defined only once in the text where they appear first.
YES	Anywhere	Check out carefully to ensure that SI units are used everywhere. Example: MPa and not Mpa.
YES	Anywhere	Use standard IJP terminology where possible (examples: backcalculation, in situ, nondestructive, nonlinear, micromechanical, viscoelastic, viscoplastic, antistripping).
YES	Anywhere	Correct paragraph style (left justified and one line space before new para). Refrain from one-sentence or two-lines paragraphs. Except title (in 12 font size), all other headings and text must be regular 11 font size left-justified.
YES	Anywhere	Cite references in the text in Arabic numeral within parenthesis. Example [1], or [1,2,3]. Not [1],[2],[3] and not [1, 2, 3]. Replace by [1,2,3]. References must be numbered in sequence.
YES	Table Figure	Correct table titles (on top of table) and figure titles (below figure) in the IJP format. Rearrange or reduce figure size and table to fit in maximum allowed pages. Do not use period at the end of title of figures and tables. Use only first capital letter in first word only in title.
YES	Figures and Equations	Remove border and grey background. Lettering not smaller than 8 font size. Figures must have readable lettering and English style numbering. Figures in low resolution are not acceptable.
YES	Conclusions	Include a section on conclusions and recommendations based on what you presented; remove any conclusion if not supported by data and discussions in the preceding sections.
YES	Acknowledgement	Include Acknowledgement and Disclaimer as appropriate. Remove titles in names.
YES	References	Correct reference style in reference section. Provide year and page numbers of journal and conference proceeding papers. Reference list must fully follow the latest IJP format. Replace D.C. by DC in the reference list.
YES	Anywhere	Address thoroughly in the revised paper all other technical comments by ALL reviewers with more references, if necessary. All comments should be incorporated in the revised text.
YES	Anywhere	Proof read carefully and correct all typos and incorrect words and where there is no space or more spaces between words.
YES	Anywhere	Edit and proof (several times) before you send your revised paper for publication in the next issue. Remove person's titles.
	Appendix	Include Appendix after Reference section if 20 or more acronyms are used in the text.

Your revised paper must address all reviewers' comments whether you agree or do not agree with them.
